WHERE DOES YOUR PROSPECTIVE M.P. STAND ON RHODESIA?

1. In September, 1976, Ian Smith and the Rhodesian Government accepted Anglo-American proposals for majority rule. They were promised that once a Transitional Government had been established the British and American Governments would lift sanctions and use their influence to stop the terrorist war.

Ian Smith and the other black and white leaders of the Rhodesian Transitional Government have kept their word!

David Owen and Andrew Young have broken theirs!

2. The Transitional Government, as created by the Salisbury Agreement of March, 1978, contains leaders of the three main African parties and of white Rhodesians. The leaders of the Patriotic Front have been asked by the parties to that Agreement to take part in the Government and to help plan a new constitution. They have refused to do this. Instead, they have announced their intention to seize power through the barrel of a gun. They say they will reject any constitution which is not dictated by themselves, after they have seized power.

Civilians murdered

3. Owen and Young have described the activities of the Patriotic Front as a "liberation struggle". Since the beginning of this year 3 975 black Rhodesian civilians and 207 white Rhodesian civilians have been murdered, and many more maimed or crippled by these "liberators". Women, children and elderly men have been among those burned alive, bayoneted or disfigured. Such is the way of the Marxist bully boy, who rules only through intimidation or fear.

4. Owen and Young have agreed that the Rhodesian Security Forces should be virtually disbanded and that law and order should be maintained by the "liberation armies" of the Patriotic Front. Is this British justice? Is this responsible behaviour towards one of the most orderly and enlightened communities in Africa?

5. Owen and Young claim (at least in public) to be impartial on the Rhodesian question. Is it "impartial" to wage an unremitting propaganda campaign against the efforts of the Transitional Government? Is it "impartial" to force Rhodesians to endure the burden of sanctions, while they are fighting a deadly war against terrorist enemies? Why have Owen and Young brought no pressures to bear to curb the activities of the Patriotic Front?

Infamous betrayal

6. Probably never before in our history has a British Government stooped to such an infamous betrayal in order to appease foreign interests. Surely the lives and happiness of black and white Rhodesians are more important than Nigerian oil, or President Carter's re-elections, or the international socialist revolution?

Surely the Americans have no right to require a British Government to connive at the execution of British people?

7. It is emphatically *not* too late! The people of Rhodesia have got the guts and the determination to play their part. They intend to build a free and non-racial society in Zimbabwe. But they may succumb to tyranny if YOU do not care enough to help them. *It's time the voice of Britain spoke out loud and clear!*
