PROCEDURE.

During the week following the Election of Councillors each year, the City Council customarily holds a Special Meeting. At this Special Meeting the Mayor for the ensuing year is elected by the City Council and is invested with the Chain of Office.

Under the Chairmanship of the newly appointed Mayor the City Council appoints Members of the several Committees of the Council for the ensuing year.

Before the elections and appointments are made, His Worship the Mayor for the year then ending addresses the Council upon Municipal developments during his Year of Office.
